2023 Scholarship Committee Results: A Success All Round!

Committee Members: Cori, Deena, Joanne, Shannon S., Kinn, Lauren, Claire, Steve (chair)

Asbury High School (all seniors were eligible)

- Awards totaling \$2,000 were presented 6/6
- One scholarship for \$1,000, two for \$500 each

Allied Health (Key Club Seniors)

- Award will be presented 6/15
- One scholarship for \$1,000



Putting the EHN Funds to Work for Asbury's Youth: So Far

We have an obligation to the donors to follow through on our commitment to use the funds for Asbury Park youth enrichment.

AP Little League: We've sponsored the RedSox (6-7yo). Funds are being used used for uniforms, equipment. (Also important for Westside relations with parents.)

Scholarships: 4 scholarships were awarded, totaling \$3,000

Sharing the Profits: We are spreading the EHN revenues to other non-profits, via coupon codes and tabling. The list includes the Asbury Park Music Foundation, AP Women's Club, Keyport Kiwanis, AP Rotary Club, AP Little League, and Beach Badge Initiative. End result will be upwards to \$1500 shared.



Putting the EHN Funds to Work for Asbury's Youth: In the Works

- Fun in the Park Event at Springwood Park This Summer Service Project needs support ASAP
- Movie Day at the Showroom: Rent the 66-room theater for 2 shows, for small and older kids.
- Drag Event to benefit Project R.E.A.L slated for October
- **Book Ark:** We placed 1 ark last year at Bradley Elementary -- 750 books distributed so far! Plans are to construct/place at least 2 more this year around the community. (The AP Rotary Club wants to help.)
- Other Potential Projects: Library programs, NARCAN training/giveaway, Back to School Day at Bradley Elementary, etc. We are collecting more ideas!

We need more owners/volunteers for these projects!

A SMOOTH-RUNNING PROCESS

- There have been no system bugs or glitches
- Orders placed, auto-generates confirmation email/#
- Abandoned Carts Reminders
- Orders mailed same-day (Karen/Stacie), delivery in 2-6 days (a handful of issues with the USPS)
- 20 elected porch pickup

SALES RESULTS

- Online Sales: We've reached <u>400</u> Online Orders and approx. 550 booklets sold!
- Some trickling marketing campaigns to sell off the remaining inventory (APMF, Key Club, Cori tabling at Beach Badge 7/13 fundraiser)
- Total Estimated Profits? \$?

MOST IMPORTANT OUTCOME

- We now have a marketing database of 400 buyers/donors
- Can trigger emails for future fundraisers
- Several are interested in volunteering or joining

WHAT'S NEXT

- August: Go-NoGo decision for 2024
- If a Go, Steve cannot run the project (but will mentor). If no one steps up, likely hand it off to another N-P for % of 1st year profits.
