## **Reports and Updates -**

President's Report: Deena reported that sale of EHN books brought in \$900 at the recent Asbury Park Restaurant Tour and updated Eat, Here, Now stats - \$12,987 in sales with \$8500 net proceeds.

The Asbury Book Co-op sold many books and has 15 more to sell.

**Book Ark Launch:** Mount Carmel School event 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Kiwanis will man a table with the book ark launch at 6:30 p.m. A discussion was held to sell books or give out snacks. Volunteers are needed.

Steve reported that he had picked up 1400 books from Bridge of Books.

**Community Resource Fair/Literacy Day:** Sat. May 31 at the Library, 12 p.m. to 2 p.m.

**Mercy Center Food Pantry:** Valle said she worked Thursday and there were 927 clients that came through.

Celia and Community Karma is helping with volunteers for evening hours in June which will be held every Tuesday evening until 6 p.m. for a 1 ½ hour shift. Volunteers are needed.

**Beach Borrow Box:** Members may donate toys or we will provide funding from the club treasury. Members discussed funding a second beach box at North End playground. Steve was asked about providing another one. Last year many of the toys did not make their way back into the box so it was suggested the word borrow be prominent.

Shannon suggested we should wait to see if there is money in the budget. Deena said Kearny Bank in Ocean Grove wants to help out so we can let them know what we need.

**Allaire Community Farm:** Wendy said she booked Oct. 25 at 2:30 for the event. When it gets closer volunteers will be solicited.

**Play on Pine:** Select Friday nights in the summer from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m., consensus was that members want to do it again this year. Wendy explained that the town brings a Fire Truck which provides water. Part of the road is cordoned off and kids can play, use sidewalk chalk etc. We provide snacks, juice and maybe books. Kerry Martin of Second Life Bikes sponsored it last year. Volunteers are needed.

**Scholarship Committee**: the committee met, the total budget is \$3000, with one scholarship of \$500 being given to Gloria Ann Gonzalez who attends College Achieve.
